**Second Collection Today for CAFOD (Family Fast)**

FROM FR MICHAEL

Reflect on what a powerful thing it is to make the sign of the cross on your own body. You are identifying yourself- body, mind and soul – with the cruel and painful death of Jesus of Nazareth. You are identifying yourself with the God who is Love, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Never allow making the sign of the cross to become a meaningless routine!

Maybe when you come into church you cross yourself with holy water. This is after all the very house of God, the threshold of Heaven. Again please do reflect on the holiness of this place.

Today is Sunday School for families preparing for First Holy Communion. Caroline Quinn will be instructing the children in church about the Cross. If you come in time please join in and listen. I will be having a session with parents in the Parish Room.

Tomorrow evening sees the beginning of Journey in Faith 2018/19 – an opportunity for all of us to grow in our faith. First session is Passover and Eucharist. What is the Mass? Why is it so important? What is God's relationship to his people? And what is happening to us when we share in the Mass? We will be using the prayers and readings for Maundy Thursday. And the session will be repeated on Tuesday morning.
