**FROM FR MICHAEL**

On 13 October a priest from Birmingham is going to be canonised. Born in 1801 John Henry Newman became a highly influential clergyman in the Church of England. His prayer and his study slowly caused him to believe that it was the Roman Catholic Church that was the "One Fold of Christ". He was received into full communion by Blessed Dominic Barberi in 1845, a time when such a conversion was much more traumatic than it might be today. Not surprisingly he is looked on as something of a hero by those of us who have followed a similar path.

As I now prepare for another big change in my life I am much comforted by one of Newman's famous sayings: "To live is to change and to be perfect is to have changed often".

To help us all to deal with some of this change I invite you to come to church on Saturday 21 September (10.30 – 12.30) to pray before the Blessed Sacrament. I have also invited members of the Ordinariate of Our Lady of Walsingham to join us.
