Today is Vocations Sunday. On Sunday 26th May Bishop William will be here to celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation. On Saturday the 20th July John Waters will be ordained priest at St Chad's Cathedral by Archbishop Bernard. What is the connection? The connection is the oil of Chrism, the oil of gladness, the anointing of the Holy Spirit, conferred, celebrated and poured out in the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Ordination. Our belonging to Christ, our membership of the Church, our ministry and priesthood, is always a gift from on high, a calling from God Himself, a summons to eternal life. We hear much these days of the evils of clericalism, that sense of entitlement, power and privilege that can so easily insinuate itself into the hearts and minds of any one of us. Our vocation is to die to self and to be open to the Spirit of God, to be channels of the Holy Spirit and to be men and women of healing and peace.
