This week we celebrate three important feasts: Saint Mary Magdalene, the first person to whom the Risen Christ appeared, 'a disciple of the Lord who played a leading role in the Gospels' (Benedict XVI). We remember our brothers and sisters at our neighbouring Anglican church. Saint Bridget - a mother of eight and founder of the Brigettine order, for men and women in the fourteenth Century. Saint James the Apostle, witness to the great miracles of Jesus, martyred in AD42, and today, venerated in Compostela, in Spain.
